Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$6,000 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

2022 FBI National Academy Associates (FBINAA) Training Conference – \$5,000. This contribution will provide funding in support of the 2022 FBINAA Training Conference scheduled for July 11 through July 14, 2022 in Sarasota, Florida. The funding will be used to help with costs to cover conference materials and training expenses.

Autism Society of Greater Orlando (ASGO) - \$1,000. This contribution will provide funding in support of the 17th Annual Autism Family Fun Day fundraiser to be held on April 16, 2022. The ASGO provides instruction to law enforcement officers on how to deal with autistic individuals and is involved in the success of the Crisis Intervention Team training.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$6,000 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for an eligible contribution to 2022 FBI National Academy Associates Training Conference (\$5,000) and Autism Society of Greater Orlando (\$1,000).

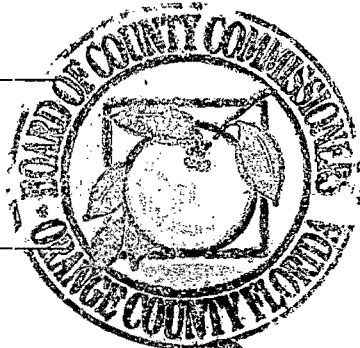
