SUBJECT: Appointment of Assistant County Administrator

As you may recall, following Darren Gray's resignation as Deputy County Administrator, Carla Bell Johnson was promoted from Assistant County Administrator to Deputy County Administrator, leaving her previous role vacant. Over the past few months, the County Administrator and I have evaluated the needs of the organization, including some structural adjustments. With the objective of continuing to strengthen our financial and fiscal acumen, we conducted a recruitment for an Assistant County Administrator. I am pleased to announce the appointment of Lisa Snead as Assistant County Administrator. Subject to confirmation by the Board of County Commissioners, her start date will be July 11, 2022.

Ms. Snead began her career with Orange County Government, having worked for more than 11 years in the Office of Management and Budget, Risk Management, Human Resources, and the Convention Center. She has more than 20 years of diverse and progressively responsible professional experience in local government organizations, including various fiscal and financial management roles within Lake County, Seminole County, and the City of Longwood. Most recently, she served as the Chief Financial Officer of Volusia County Public Schools, overseeing Finance, Budget, and Risk Management for the school district. Ms. Snead will have primary oversight of our financial and administrative offices, including the Office of Management and Budget, Fiscal and Business Services, Information Systems and Services, Risk Management, and Human Resources. Ms. Snead's starting annual salary will be \$170,019, and her resume is attached for your review.
