**Our Community Salutes USA Inc, OCS Enlistee Recognition Ceremony - \$500.** This organization's mission is to recognize and honor high school seniors who plan to enlist in the U.S. Armed Services after graduation. The program provides enlistees and their parents with guidance, information, resources, and community support from like-minded enlistees and parents as their son or daughter transitions into military service. This contribution is in support of the OCS Enlistee Recognition Ceremony 2026, to be held on April 22, 2026, in Orlando, Florida.

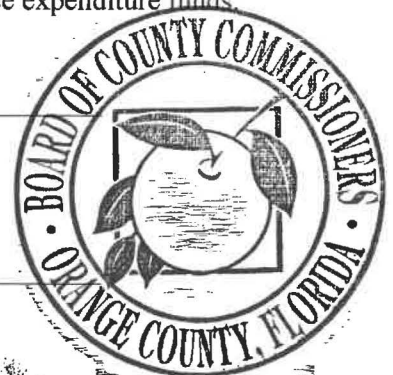

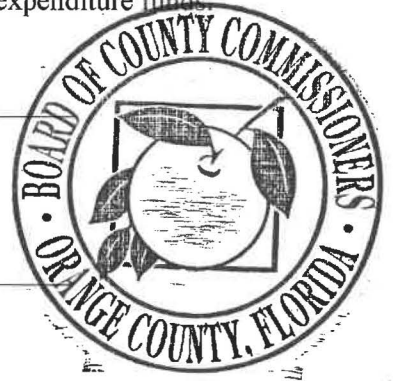
