RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of three firms and two ranked alternates to provide Utilities Continuing Geotechnical Engineering and Materials Testing Services, Request for Proposals Y20-904-TA, from the following firms, listed alphabetically. Further, request authorization for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute three annual contracts to establish hourly rates for future requirements. Further, request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contracts for two additional one-year terms.

Ardaman & Associates, Inc.

Geotechnical and Environmental Consultants, Inc.

Professional Service Industries, Inc.

Terracon Consultants, Inc.

Universal Engineering Sciences, Inc.

This item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on June 29, 2020. Commissioner Emily Bonilla was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

These contracts will provide continuing geotechnical engineering and materials testing services for water utilities, wastewater utilities, and resource recovery projects for the Utilities Department. Services include, but are not limited to, subsurface soil investigation, soil tests for construction, structural steel analysis, pile load testing, reinforcing steel analysis, roofing analysis, aquifer performance testing, groundwater modeling, or monitoring. Other services to be performed may include preparation of various soils, materials, and geotechnical reports, permitting with regulatory agencies, ground penetrating radar investigations, and visits to inspect field conditions.

DISCUSSION:

Six proposals were received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth

in the RFP. The proposal submitted by Madrid Engineering scored too low for Board consideration. Consensus scores from the Procurement Committee are attached.

A timely protest was filed by Geotechnical and Environmental Consultants, Inc. The protest committee heard the protest on August 11, 2020, resulting in a unanimous vote to uphold the original scores for Geotechnical and Environmental Consultants, Inc. No appeal was filed.
