For equipping, renovating, maintaining, constructing and

acquiring

 Governed by Florida Statutes (funded through Tourist Development Tax)

Cultural Facilities Funding



- Application (with \$1:\$1 match) due February 2024
 - Increased request cap: \$2,000,000 (previously \$500,000)
- Site Visits March 2024
- Panel Review April 2024 Scoring according to matrix:
 - Concept (Need, Vision, Inspiring Excellence)
 - Facility (Process, Design, Planning, Quality)
 - Management & Budget (Readiness, Stewardship)
- Minimum scoring threshold to be eligible (80/100)






Lowndes Shakespeare Center: Renovation & Refurbishment
