SUBJ: Installation of "No Parking" Signs on Azalea Cove Circle

A concerned citizen has requested that "No Parking" signs be established on both sides of Azalea Cove Circle at its entrance and the interior curves of the circle.

The request for parking restrictions is to address pedestrian safety incidences and hazardous driving conditions caused by vehicles parking on both sides of the road and at blind corners. Ballots were mailed to the property owners impacted. Upon receipt of the ballots confirming that two-thirds of residents are in favor of the "No Parking" signs, the County will proceed with the installation request. The result of the survey indicated that 68% of the property owners approve the "No Parking" signs.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of "No Parking" signs on both sides of Azalea Cove Circle at its entrance and the interior curves of the circle.

Action Requested: Approval of "No Parking" signs installation on both sides of Azalea Cove Circle at its entrance and the interior curves of the circle. District 3.
