SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 4, Contract Y20-2019, Provision of Community Services and Facility Use

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 4, Contract Y20-2019, Provision of Community Services and Facility Use, with Employ U, Inc., in the amount of \$150,000, for a revised contract total amount of \$450,000.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will extend the contract for the period of July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 and provides additional funding for the extension period. The alignment of the contract term with the calendar year will allow these contracts to provide continuity of services accompanied by calendar year funding.

FUNDING:

APPROVALS:

The Citizens' Commission for Children Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

The Board approved Contract Y20-2019 on February 25, 2020. Employ U, Inc. is currently providing services under this contract such as vocational opportunities for persons with disabilities, including employability skills, paid on-the-job training, paid internships, and awareness of community resources to promote independence for persons within East and West Orange County.
