On April 22, 2025, the Board accepted an agreement from the U.S. Department of Transportation, through the State of Florida Department of Transportation and awarded to the Public Works Department, the Local Agency Program - Rock Springs Road project in the amount of \$643,046.

Funding will be utilized to design complete street improvements on Rock Springs Road. The project is consistent with the Rock Springs Road Study-Corridor Study Report and includes the design of intersection improvements, access management improvements, new and upgraded traffic signalization, signage and pavement markings, street lighting, ADA improvements, utility adjustments, and permitting. The budget period for this award ends on December 31, 2026.

On February 11, 2025, the Board accepted from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, through the Florida Department of Emergency Management, a sub-award for the State Homeland Security Grant Program – Issue 3 (Special Response Team Hazmat Sustainment).

The sub-award, in the amount of \$48,400, will allow the Orange County Fire Rescue Department to purchase updated equipment and support the sustainment of current equipment cache for the Hazmat Program. The performance period for this grant is from November 1, 2024 through August 31, 2026.
