ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y23-765-CC, Downey Park Pickleball Courts, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Sloan Builders, Inc., in the total contract award amount of \$1,329,642, inclusive of additive numbers one and two.

PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract includes the construction of six new pickleball courts, parking, drainage, and site improvements at Downey Park. Bid additive number one includes the construction of concrete sidewalks, pavement and slabs, two additional pickleball courts for a total of eight, four benches, and a fence between and around the courts. Bid additive number two involves electrical work to include lighting the pickleball courts and parking area, connection to the transformer, a new meter, and power for a new irrigation system. The project is located in District 4.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1265-062-2165-6310.

APPROVALS:

The Capital Projects and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Five bids were received in response to the Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bid submitted by GEL Recycling was deemed non-responsive by the Procurement Division, for failure to provide the bid bond and other required forms. The bid submitted by

Close Construction Services, LLC was deemed non-responsive by the Procurement Division, based on the analysis provided by the Business Development Division, which identified that the M/WBE participation goal was not achieved, and good faith effort documentation was not provided. The low bid is considered reasonable based on current market factors. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Sloan Builders, Inc. has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Sloan Builders, Inc. The budget can only support the lowest bidder.

The Business Development Division evaluated the three bids submitted for this project. The Business Development Division completed a M/WBE Availability Analysis. The scope of services for this project had M/WBE availability. As a result, the M/WBE goal remained at 25%. At the time of bid opening; at least 71 firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bid, submitted by Sloan Builders, Inc., reported 32.35% in M/WBE participation. While they listed M/WBE firms in their bid, they did not specify scope of service on attachment C-2.

Business Development issued a Submittal of Clarification email request on March 23, 2023, for the low bidder to submit:

- Good Faith Effort Action #4- No documentation submitted pertaining to quotes
- Good Faith Effort Action #5- Yes documentation submitted

The third low bid did not meet the Orange County M/WBE participation goal per the Ordinance requirement. Good Faith Effort (GFE) was not achieved per the Ordinance requirement if the M/WBE goal is not met. Therefore, GFE was not achieved. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:
