

- BCC approval of Florida Job Growth Infrastructure Agreement on June 18, 2019 providing for \$16 million grant from DEO








Project Details:

- Length 1.7 miles
- Reconfigured interchange at Sand Lake
 Road
- New stormwater management treatment
- New bus, bike, pedestrian, lighting, and landscape features







Ownership Limits:

- —Orange County
 - Segments 1 and 2: Universal Boulevard to southern interchange ramps with Sand Lake Road
- -FDOT
 - Segment 3: Southern interchange ramps to Carrier Drive
- Design underway all segments
 - Universal Boulevard to CarrierDrive









- Typical Section (Orange County)
 - **−6 general travel lanes**
 - -Two special purpose transit lanes

Funding summary:

- -\$16 million grant from State of Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO)
 - Work to commence on or before June 1, 2020
 - Funds to be used for portion of roadway within FDOT rights of way (interchange)
 - Invoice submittal as reimbursement requirement







- Funding summary (continued)
 - \$25 million in road impact fee credits resulting from additional roadway capacity created
 - Consistent with County's road impact fee ordinance
 - -\$60 million reimbursement CRA Trust Fund
 - -\$40 million tax rebate incentive funds from CRA
 - Annual installment payments based on incremental growth in Universal's taxable property values
 - CRA Trust Fund and rebate funds made available upon construction completion of the project



- Funding summary (continued)
 - -Estimated project cost: approx. \$305 million
 - -Final project costs subject to construction contract
 - Orange County's obligation limited to no more than\$125 million in combined funding sources/incentives
 - Balance of project costs borne by Universal (approximately \$180 million)

RESOLUTION - Proposed Revisions

WHEREAS, the Board, sitting as the International Drive Community Redevelopment Agency, has recommended modification to the Plan to authorize additional community redevelopment projects in the International Drive Community Redevelopment Area and to extend the duration of the Plan until the year 2040 in order to provide sufficient time to complete implementation of redevelopment projects in the Area; and



RESOLUTION - Proposed Revisions

Section 1. It is hereby found and determined that the International Drive Community Redevelopment Plan adopted by the Board on September 29, 1998 pursuant to Resolution 98-M-43, as modified by Resolution No. 03-M-17, adopted by the Board on June 3, 2003, Resolution No. 06-M-59, adopted by the Board on September 12, 2006 and Resolution 2009-M-39 adopted by the Board on September 1, 2009 (collectively, the "Plan") shall be modified to extend the duration of the Plan to January 1, 2040 to provide sufficient time to complete implementation of redevelopment in the Area and shall be further modified as shown on Exhibit "A" to this Resolution.
