**AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO ORANGE COUNTY
SEALS AND LOGOS; AMENDING SECTION 2-3 OF THE
ORANGE COUNTY CODE; UPDATING THE LOGOS AND
SEALS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

12 **WHEREAS**, on March 11, 1997, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County,
14 Florida (“BCC”), pursuant to Section 165.043, Florida Statutes, adopted Ordinance No. 97-01,
16 establishing the Official County Seal, the Official Mayor’s Seal, and the Official County Logo;
18 and

16 **WHEREAS**, Orange County’s official seals and logo were subsequently revised on June
18, 2013 via Ordinance No. 2013-14; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the BCC now desires to update and modernize the Official County Seal, the
22 Official Mayor’s Seal, and the Official County Logo, to reflect current branding and design
24 standards.

26 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE
28 COUNTY:

26 ***Section 1. Amendment to Section 2-3.*** Section 2-3 of the Orange County Code
28 (“Official Logos and Seals”) is hereby amended and updated as follows, with additions being
30 shown by underlines and deletions being shown by strike-throughs:

32 Section 2-3. Official county seals and logos.

34 (a) *Legislative findings and intent.* From time to time the county board of
36 commissioners and the county mayor both need to use official seals, as
38 authorized by section 165.043, Florida Statutes, to indicate the authority
40 of the county on documents of legal significance, to indicate the action
42 of the county mayor on documents of legal import and as symbols of
44 their offices and authority. Furthermore, all county officials, employees,

36 and divisions and departments should use an official logo to indicate the
38 involvement, sponsorship, aegis, or ownership of the county in various
publications, letterhead, presentations, signs, and other appurtenances
40 that in and of themselves do not have legal import. The legislative intent
42 of this section is to (1) designate official county seals that may be used
from time to time by the board of county commissioners, the county
44 mayor, the county comptroller and his/her designated deputy clerks, and
certain other county employees, (2) to designate an official county logo
46 that should be employed by all county officials, employees, and
divisions and departments, and (3) to designate an official Orange TV
48 logo that should be used by all employees of the Orange TV Unit of the
county.

48 (b) *Definitions.*

50 *The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) seal* means the visual
52 design presented below, displayed in any form, whether painted, drawn,
printed, electronically reproduced, stamped, embossed, or otherwise.






