ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 2, Contract Y19-801, Opinion of Value for Pluris Wedgefield, Inc., with Hartman Consultants, LLC, in the amount of \$83,095, for a revised total contract amount of \$167,095.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will provide additional engineering services related to Phase 3 of the work of a specified nature for Orange County Utilities in evaluating and pursuing the potential acquisition of Pluris Wedgefield, Inc. Water and Wastewater System.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4420-038-1322-3110.

APPROVALS:

The Utilities Engineering Division concurs with this recommendation.

DISCUSSION:

On November 13, 2018, the Board authorized the selection of Hartman Consultants, LLC and authorized negotiation and execution of a contract by the Procurement Division provided that the contract does not exceed the budget amount of \$55,000. The contract was executed on September 20, 2021, in the amount of \$53,000.

Phase 3 services include developing and transmitting the data request; facilities inspections; review of facilities quantification, data, and costing; performance of a market approach of water and wastewater sales in Florida; performance of a direct capitalization of net revenues; and completion of a preliminary Tangible Personal Property and Intangible Property value consulting analysis. The effort culminates with an appraisal and appraisal report which complies with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice.
