#### **1965**

Orange County established Air and Water
 Pollution Control Act

#### **1985**

DEP designated EPD as a "locally approved air program" and authorized funding

#### **1989**

- General Operating Agreement delineated each agency's authorities
- GOA Delegates the duties and responsibilities by a Specific Operating Agreement





## Specific Operating Agreement

- Outlines air program duties & responsibilities
  - Air Program Management
  - Permitting
  - Compliance & Enforcement
  - Ambient Air Monitoring
  - Data Management
- Renewed every three years
- Requires ordinance to be current with DEP rules





- EPA's National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPs) and the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)
- Minor changes incorporated to F.A.C. as follows:
  - 62-204 Air Pollution Control-General Provisions
  - 62-210 Stationary Sources- General Requirements
    - ➤ Definitions, Permits Required & Air General Permits, Stack Height Policy, Excess Emissions, Forms and Instructions
  - 62-243 Tampering With Motor Vehicle Air Pollution Control
     Equipment
    - Exemptions & Certification
  - 62-296 Stationary Sources- Emission Standards (Certain Rules Repealed)
    - ➤ Portland Cement Plants, Carbonaceous Fuel Burners, Lime Kilns, Smelt Dissolving Tanks



### Required relatively minor amendment changes to Ch. 15 Article III

Section	Title	Amendment change
15-70	Definitions	Added "any" to clarify matter in the Open Burning definition
15-71	Violations; penalties and remedies	Updated reference year from 2011 to 2015
15-89	Permits required; permitting generally; exceptions from permitting; permit application processing; variances and waivers; exemptions; final agency action for permits; temporary noncompliance	Added clarifying language to section 15-89(c)(2), 15-89(c)(4), & 15-89(c)(6) to be consistent with scope of services as authorized in the Specific Operating Agreement (SOA) between FDEP and Orange County
15-89.1	Air pollution prohibited	Deleted language referencing Number 1 on the Ringlemann Chart Added reference to use EPA Method 9

15-90	Adoption of state and federal rules by reference	Updated reference year 2017 to 2018.
15-96 (c)	Prohibitions	Added new language to reference new Burn Ban Activation per section 18-4 under Ordinance No 2018-07
15-98	Open burning of land clearing debris	Added section (a) for clarification of list  Correction to section (c) scrivener's error  FAC rule reference from 62-292.401 to 62-296.401
