SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 2, Contract Y20-1065, Water Watch Program

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 2, Contract Y20-1065, Water Watch Program, with Aqua Cops Water Systems Incorporated, in the amount of \$218,868.74, for a revised estimated contract amount of \$1,546,955.73.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment renews the contract for a one-year term and adds funding to support a contract price escalation allowable under the contract terms, which has been validated through the U.S. Bureau of Labor and Statistics, Consumer Price Index (CPI).

FUNDING:

Funding is available in the account number 4420-038-1325-3197.

APPROVALS:

The Utilities Department concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

On July 28, 2020, the Board authorized award of Contract Y20-1065 to Aqua Cops Water Systems Incorporated, in the estimated contract total of \$1,310,612.16. In accordance with the contract, Aqua Cops Water Systems Incorporated submitted a request for a contract price escalation. The Procurement Division validated the request against the CPI, confirming its accuracy. The Utilities Department has confirmed that they are agreeable to the requested contract price escalation.
