## Report:

The property owners have requested the establishment of the MSBU for this subdivision. A total of 54 ballots were mailed to property owners to determine majority opinion. Approximately 66.7% of the ballots returned were in favor of the establishment of the MSBU. The ballot results are as follows:

In favor of the MSBU	14
Not in favor of the MSBU	7
Returned undeliverable	1
Received after deadline	0
No ballots submitted	<u>32</u>
Total ballots distributed	54

The estimated cost for the amending MSBU is \$241.00 per lot, per year. The establishing MSBU would be effective **November 1, 2025**.
