The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$5,000 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purpose:

Contribution:

Children's Safety Village of Central Florida – \$5,000. The Children's Safety Village is one of Orange County's essential resources for life-safety education for young children. Last year staff served over 22,000 community residents with programs and services focused on drowning prevention, pedestrian and bike safety, gun safety, internet safety, and dangerous person awareness. The 6th Annual Community Heroes Celebration will be held on Friday evening, May 19, 2023, at Leu Gardens.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$5,000 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for an eligible contribution to the Children's Safety Village of Central Florida.

- 7) Other law enforcement expenditures

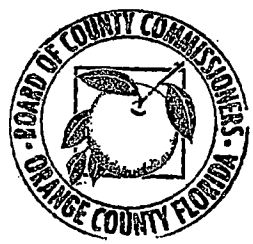
