SUBJ: Installation of "No Parking" signs on Kenmore Lane

Residents on Kenmore Lane expressed concerns related to the ability of emergency vehicles to access their homes when vehicles are parked on both sides of the street.

The Fire Rescue Department has confirmed that allowing parking on both sides of the street impedes emergency vehicles from accessing certain portions of the subdivision, thereby creating a public safety hazard. Florida Fire Prevention Code, Section 18.2.3.4.1.1, requires that fire department access roads shall have an unobstructed width of no less than 20 feet. In addition, the Florida Fire Prevention Code, Section 18.2.4.1.1, states that the required width of a fire department access road shall not be obstructed in any manner, including the parking of vehicles.

The Fire Marshal recommends the Board approve the installation of "No Parking" signs for both sides of Kenmore Lane to ensure safe access of emergency vehicles.
