ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 8, Contract Y18-1124, Motor Fuels – Tank Wagon Deliveries, with Palmdale Oil Company, Inc., in the amount of \$316,114.60, for a revised estimated contract amount of \$2,707,708.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will extend the contract term for the period of October 7, 2023 through January 6, 2024 and provide additional funding to meet projected needs based on the County's usage to date while a new procurement process is complete. The Procurement Division is projecting to issue the re-solicitation by mid-September.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account numbers 5530-043-2035-4180, 5530-043-2035-4185, 5530-043 2035-4186, and 5530-043-2035-4187.

APPROVALS:

The Fleet Management Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

On October 2, 2018, the Board authorized award of contract Y18-1124 to Palmdale Oil Company, Inc., in the estimated amount of \$1,900,000 for a one-year term, with four additional one-year renewal terms.

Increased the total contract amount by \$282,708, for a revised estimated Amendment No. 6: contract amount of \$2,277,708. The Board approval was obtained on October 11, 2022.

Amendment No. 7: Increased the total contract amount by \$113,885.40 for a revised estimated contract amount of \$2,391,593.40.
