TransMAC Committee Chair Grimmer and Vice Chair Moldof met to discuss Transportation.

Public Comment

Topics Discussed

Chair Grimmer and Vice Chair Moldof met to discuss the vision for future TransMAC meetings. The conversation focused on opportunities to strengthen collaboration among various micromobility stakeholders in Orange County. Lauren Torres, Public Works Senior Project Manager, contributed to the discussion. She disclosed that the county is currently gathering information from different stakeholders and will present its findings to the Orange County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) in May. Additionally, Lauren Torres recommended members hold off on defining TransMAC's role until the BCC's direction becomes clear following the meeting in May. Discussion ensued.

Vice Chair Moldof discussed his request for a study aimed at examining what other jurisdictions are doing with technology to interface with their transportation systems and its design to provide residents with an unbiased connection to local transportation options. Discussion ensued.

Future Action Plan

Chair Grimmer asked Vice Chair Moldof to develop a strategic plan outlining the key topics of focus, identifying appropriate stakeholders to invite, and proposing a meeting structure to study micromobility.
