AN ORDINANCE OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 8 (“BOATS AND WATER SAFETY”) OF THE ORANGE COUNTY CODE BY CREATING SECTION 8-38; DESIGNATING A SWIM AREA AND VESSEL-EXCLUSION ZONE IN A PORTION OF LAKE BUTLER, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED ON APPENDIX “A”; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
