WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority by law to enact and, from time to time, amend fees charged by Orange County departments for services rendered to the public; and

WHEREAS, Orange County can legally charge a fee for such services that captures the reasonable cost associated with administrative, personal services, operating, capital, and overhead to provide that service; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Fire Rescue Department has recommended a change in certain "Fire and Life Safety Inspection Services" fee amounts in order to make the fee imposition fairly reflect the actual cost of service provision; and

WHEREAS, the County's Office of Management and Budget concurs with the recommendation that the Board approve the revisions to the schedule of fees as to services rendered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County hereby approves the schedule of fees attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and thereby amends the existing fee schedule.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately, and the rates established hereby shall take effect on October 1, 2023, or as soon afterward as is practical.
