SUBJECT: U.S. Department of Justice –FY17 Justice Assistance Grant Program Consent Agenda - July 31, 2018

The U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance has awarded Orange County, as governing body, a FY17 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program – Local Solicitation, Award Number 2017-DJ-BX-0933, in the amount of \$394,335 with no required match. The grant period is from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2020. The grant will provide funding to support the following law enforcement and prevention initiatives to essential county services.

Victim Service Center of Central Florida, Inc. – funding will used to pay for a part-time Education Coordinator to work on the development and delivery of a youth character development education program for K-12 that will focus on education, prevention and support services on crime and crime prevention. The Victim Service Center will also develop a training video designed for effective delivery of the curriculum for a total amount of \$52,020.

Orange County Corrections Department– funding will be used to purchase selfcontained breathing apparatus used by Corrections Officers to provide breathable air in an immediate danger to life or health. Its primary use is for the safe and effective evacuation of both staff and the inmate population during heavy smoke and fire in the amount of \$60,000.

Orange County Neighborhood Preservation and Revitalization Office funding will used to purchase and install new street lights (where appropriate) and update the fixture to light emitting diode (LED) lights in the Tildenville area in the amount of \$3,000. 07/31/18 - BCC Consent Agenda Page 2 of 2 July 19, 2018

Orange County Sheriff's Office Administrative Services – funding will be used to purchase four rifle rated armor shields with view port for the Fugitive Apprehension Unit in the amount of \$25,812. The rifle rated armor shields offers more protection than body armor and current handgun rated shields.

Orange County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations – funding will be used to purchase the Clandestine Lab Response Team (CLRT) with 12 ballistic entry vests, 12 ballistic helmets, and 12 full face respirator voice amplifiers in the amount of \$62,748. The equipment will provide the CLRT members the means to safely clear a structure in order to begin collecting evidence and disposing of dangerous narcotics and chemicals contained inside structures.

Orange County Sheriff's Office Uniform Patrol Division – funding will be used to purchase active shooter response kits for sworn patrol personnel. The kits will include a plate carrier with level four protection, a Kevlar helmet, and the associated pouches in the amount of \$168,255. Equipping our first responders with entry level body armor will give them a greater sense of confidence when approaching dangerous individuals associated with an active shooter scenario or terrorist attack.

Orange County Drug Free Office – funding will be used to purchase nasal spray naloxone through Adapt Pharma for identified heroin-addicted inmates at the Orange County Jail in the amount of \$22,500.
