**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y20-707-FH, Vineland Avenue and S.R. 535 (Kissimmee-Vineland Road) Intersection Improvements, FPID: 435554-1-58-01 FAN: D519-035-B, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Atlantic Civil Constructors Corp. in the total contract award amount of \$1,079,121.54.

**PROCUREMENT:**

Work under this contract consists of constructing a second westbound to northbound right turn lane on Vineland Avenue onto S.R. 535 (Kissimmee-Vineland Road). The project includes resurfacing and widening along S.R. 535 and Vineland Avenue to accommodate new auxiliary lanes, new signalization of the proposed dual lane right turn lanes into northbound S.R. 535, intersection lighting relocation, new overhead cantilever sign on Vineland Avenue, four-inch thick concrete sidewalk, detectable warning surfaces, pedestrian signalization, type F concrete curb and gutter, type E concrete curb and gutter, signing and pavement markings, and performance turf installation. The project is located in District 1.

**FUNDING:**

Orange County is receiving U.S. Department of Transportation funding from the Florida Department of Transportation for this project.

**APPROVALS:**

The Public Works Department and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Three bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bid submitted by Gibbs & Register, Inc. was deemed non-responsive due to failure to provide the County with the original bid bond within the established timeframe.

The bid submitted by Atlantic Civil Constructors Corp. is 28% below the engineer's estimate. Atlantic Civil Constructors Corp. has confirmed their understanding of the scope of work and their bid process. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Atlantic Civil Constructors Corp. has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Atlantic Civil Constructors Corp.
