RE: Notice of intent to accept proposal for disposition of City-owned property within the Orange Blossom Trail CRA

Dear County Comptroller:

Pursuant to Section 163.380, Florida Statutes, the City of Orlando is in the process of disposing of certain vacant City-owned property located within the Orange Blossom Trail CRA for redevelopment as affordable, multifamily, rental housing. The property is approximately 1.6 acres generally located in the Callahan neighborhood south of W. Jefferson Street, west of Benson Avenue, east of North Orange Blossom Trail and north of Polk Street, as shown on the attached map.

As a result of the City's competitive selection process, the Selection Advisory Committee's recommendation to accept the proposal of the Nu Rock Companies is scheduled for presentation to City Council on January 13, 2025. As required by Section 163.380(3)(a), Florida Statutes, this letter will serve as the City's notification to the Board of County Commissioners as the Governing Body of the Orange Blossom Trail CRA of its intention to accept the Nu Rock proposal at the January 13, 2025, City Council meeting, considering the Proposal to be in the public interest and in furtherance of the redevelopment purposes of the Community Redevelopment Act.
