The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$10,000 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purpose:

**Contribution:**

**Orange County Police Athletic League (PAL) – \$10,000.** This contribution provides funding for a juvenile crime prevention program that provides athletic, recreational, and educational activities to at-risk children. PAL allows a law enforcement officer to spend time with children in the role of coach, mentor, instructor, and role model to encourage them to avoid crime, drugs, gangs, and other acts of violence.

**ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$10,000 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for an eligible contribution to Orange County Police Athletic League.**
