Approval of Amendment No. 5, Contract Y21-1072, Parking Lot Sweeping Services with AllStar Property Services, Inc., in the amount of \$4,290, for a revised contract award amount of \$424,680.

# **REMARKS**:

On September 28, 2021, the Board authorized award of Contract Y21-1072 to AllStar Property Services, Inc. for a contract amount on \$370,590.

Previous contract amendment are as follows:

Amendment No. 1: Added service area to the Michigan Street Complex, with an increase of \$5,720, for a revised contract award amount of \$376,310.

Amendment No. 2: Added the Sheriff's Central Complex, with an increase of \$10,400, for a revised contract award amount of \$386,710.
