Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$569,416.51 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purpose:

Sheriff's Equipment:

PenLink System - \$569,416.51. The Metropolitan Bureau of Investigation (MBI) Governing Board voted to approve the purchase of a PenLink data content collection system for court authorized pen register and Title III monitoring, analysis, and reporting. The PenLink System includes hardware, software, training, support, and warranty. MBI does not have the ability to procure the PenLink System themselves from State Forfeitures, so MBI is transferring the State Forfeitures to the Orange County Sheriff's Office to procure the system.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$569,416.51 from the FY 2021 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the purchase of PenLink System.
