Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$20,000 from the FY 2024 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

**Contributions:**

**Orange County Police Athletic League – \$15,000.** This contribution will assist in hosting community service projects while learning about the many aspects of the criminal justice system, as well as supporting current and future Police Athletic League programs.

**Central Florida Crimeline Program – \$5,000.** This organization increases the safety of Central Florida through its Crimeline program. Crimeline is an anonymous tip line which assists law enforcement in solving crimes, capturing wanted fugitives, as well as preventing crime. This contribution will assist with continued services in serving the community and law enforcement. The Crimeline Golf Scramble event will be held on Monday June 3, 2024, at Heathrow Country Club, Lake Mary, FL.

**ACTION REQUESTED: Approval and execution for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$20,000 from the FY 2024 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for eligible contributions to the Orange County Police Athletic League (\$15,000) and Central Florida Crimeline Program (\$5,000).**


