The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$41,500 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Orange County Police Athletic League – \$10,000. This contribution will assist in hosting community service projects while learning about the many aspects of the criminal justice system and the Police Athletic League programs.

The VERB Kind – \$1,500. This contribution will assist this organization's mentoring program that reaches the youth inside the walls of a juvenile detention center and gives them a second chance through mentoring, education, and connecting them with community resources.

Legal Aid Society – \$5,000. This contribution provides funding for a sponsorship for the 16th Annual Breakfast of Champions fundraising event on November 16, 2023, that raises funding to provide free, quality legal services to qualified, low-income residents in Orange County.

Peace and Justice Institute – \$25,000. This contribution is for a Contract and Service Fee for CRC Ambassador and Collective Funding Partnership and will be utilized towards making a difference by intentionally engaging in principles and practices that explore, advocate, and honor the dignity of self, others, and the earth.
