This ordinance amends the Future Land Use Element and Future Land Use Map Series of the Comprehensive Plan, amending policies to reflect the adoption of Section 506. – Rural Boundary and Rural Area, of the Orange County Charter establishing the Rural Boundary / Rural Area and adopting Map 5b, to the Future Land Use Map Series to preserve rural areas, sensitive habitats, and watersheds.
