#### Subject:

Ordinance No. 2023-35 Annexing the Property at 7600 Narcoossee Road, Assigning the Industrial Future Land Use Designation (INDUST), and Initial Zoning of Industrial Park with the Aircraft Noise Overlay District (I-P/AN) (7600 Narcoossee Road, ANX2020-10001; GMP2020-10002; ZON2020-10003) (Economic Development)

#### Summary:

Ordinance No. 2023-35 will annex the ±19.5 acres property at 7600 Narcoossee Road to the limits of the City; amend the City's Growth Management Plan to change the Future Land Use map designation from the Orange County industrial designation to the City's industrial ("INDUST") designation and the zoning designation to "Industrial Park" with the Aircraft Noise overlay district ("I-P/AN").

The site currently holds a warehouse and distribution center, and the owner's interest is to annex the property to connect to the City's sewer network.

The Municipal Planning Board (MPB) recommended approval of these cases (ANX2020-10001, GMP2020-10002, ZON2020-10003) on May 26, 2020; however, the distribution center was already in review under the Orange County permitting process. So the application was placed on hold until construction was completed. The Certificate of Occupancy was issued by the County in June 2023, therefore, the annexation process is being finalized.

The first reading of the ordinance was approved at the November 13, 2023 City Council meeting.

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY ORLANDO. FLORIDA. ANNEXING CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY CERTAIN LAND GENERALLY LOCATED NORTH OF MCCOY ROAD, EAST OF NARCOOSSEE ROAD, SOUTH OF LEE VISTA BOULEVARD AND WEST OF S. GOLDENROD ROAD, AND COMPRISED OF 19.50 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, AND AMENDING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION; AMENDING THE CITY'S ADOPTED GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY AS INDUSTRIAL ON THE CITY'S OFFICIAL FUTURE LAND USE MAPS; DESIGNATING THE PROPERTY AS INDUSTRIAL PARK WITH THE AIRCRAFT NOISE OVERLAY DISTRICT ON THE CITY'S OFFICIAL ZONING MAPS; PROVIDING AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S OFFICIAL FUTURE LAND AND ZONING MAPS: PROVIDING CORRECTION OF SEVERABILITY, SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, PERMIT DISCLAIMER, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2020, the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "Orlando City Council"), accepted a petition for voluntary annexation (hereinafter the "petition") bearing the signatures of all owners of property in an area of land generally located north of McCoy road, east of Narcoossee road, south of Lee Vista Boulevard and west of S. Goldenrod road, comprised of approximately 19.50 acres of land and being precisely described by the legal description of the area by metes and bounds attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A (hereinafter the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the petition was filed with the Orlando City Council pursuant to section 171.044, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting of May 26, 2020, the Municipal Planning Board (the "MPB") of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "city"), considered the following applications relating to the Property:

- 1. Annexation case number ANX2020-10001 requesting to annex the Property into the jurisdictional boundaries of the city; and
- Growth Management Plan (hereinafter the "GMP") case number GMP2020-10002 requesting an amendment to the city's GMP to designate the Property as Industrial on the City's official future land use map; and
- 3. Zoning case number ZON2020-10003 requesting to designate the Property as Industrial Park with the Aircraft Noise overlay district (I-P/AN) on the

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City's official zoning maps (together, hereinafter referred to as the "applications"); and

WHEREAS, based upon the evidence presented to the MPB, including the information and analysis contained in the "Staff Report to the Municipal Planning Board" for application case numbers ANX2020-10001, GMP2020-10002, and ZON2020-10003 (entitled "7600 Narcoossee Road"), the MPB recommended that the Orlando City Council approve said applications and adopt an ordinance or ordinances in accordance therewith; and

WHEREAS, the MPB found that application GMP2020-10002 is consistent with:









Future Land Use - Proposed GMP2020-10002

A Growth Management Plan (GMP) amendment and initial zoning are also part of the request, to assign a future land use designation of industrial (INDUST) and an initial zoning of Industrial Park with the Aircraft Noise overlay district ("I-P/AN").
