- Board authorization to name and rename streets and roads
  - -Section 336.05, F.S.
  - County Road System Naming of Roads
  - -Section 177.142 , F.S.
  - -Land Boundaries Renaming of Subdivisions & Streets on Plats & Maps
  - -Section 21.2, O.C.
  - Naming and Renaming Roads





### ■ Section 34.178 – Street Names

- Extensions or alignment with existing streets – Must have the same name
- –Circles and courts 1 name only
- -Must be approved by 911 Manager
- –No duplicates
- -No sound alike names
- Difficult to pronounce
- -Greater than 18 letters, including spaces but not the suffix
- –No punctuation





# **Constituent Initiated Street Renaming Process**

- Adopted via Resolution 2015-M-12
  - Must be initiated by a property owner along the street
  - Requires notarized statements of no objection from at least 75% of abutting owners
  - Must not cross jurisdictional boundaries
  - Must not be a state road
  - Approved by the Board, but does not require a public hearing


### **Other Jurisdictions**

#### Orlando

- Mayor initiates process to change the name
- Notification Owners and tenants via mail & newspaper advertisement for public hearings
- Municipal Planning Board than 2 City Council meetings
- Adopted via ordinance

#### Ocoee & Winter Park

- No formal code or process
- Notification Owners and tenants via mail & newspaper advertisement for public hearing
- City Council holds 1 public hearing
- Adopted via Resolution





# **Other Jurisdictions**

### Phoenix, Arizona

- Adopted policy specific to renaming of derogatory or offensive names
- Mayor or 3 Council members initiate process
- 2 community meetings
- Notification Owners and tenants via mail and newspaper advertisement for public hearing
- City Council holds 1 public hearing
- Adopted via ordinance





## **Proposed Administrative Street Renaming Process**

Mayor/Commissioner Request **Board Discussion / Direction Technical Review** 

Mayor or Commissioner initiate process by submitting request to County Administrator with or without proposed name(s)

Item placed on next Board meeting agenda for discussion and/or direction

#### **Zoning Division to conduct technical review (60 days)**

- Map of impacted streets and abutting properties
- Inter-jurisdictional issues
- Code related issues
- Coordinated review of proposed name(s) with other Divisions/Departments
- If alternative name proposed which was not part of the review additional analysis required



## **Proposed Administrative Street Renaming Process**



After review, at the next Board meeting, the Board shall decide to change the name of the street

Zoning Division to send a notice via mail 14 days after Board decision with effective date of 60 days from notice or as determined by the Board

Zoning Division notifies all applicable organizations and entities to update their databases



- No process currently exists
- No action required today
- Board direction on if and how to proceed
