Sales Tax Trust Fund, FY 2019-20

Taxable Sales Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2019

On October 22, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners approved a resolution authorizing the issuance of the Taxable Sales Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2019. Pursuant to the resolution, the bonds will be sold through a competitive bid process and closed on December 5, 2019. The proceeds from the bonds, together with other available funding in the Sales Tax Trust Fund, will be used to achieve debt service savings by paying off the Sales Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2012B.

In accordance with Section 129.06(2)(d), Florida Statutes, the FY 2019-20 budget requires an amendment to recognize the receipt of bond proceeds and their intended use according to bond covenants.
