SUBJECT: Appointment to the Community Action Board CONSENT AGENDA ITEM JANUARY 11, 2022

The Community Action Board (CAB) is responsible for development, review, supervision, evaluation, and making recommendations for final approval of all fiscal and program policies, plans, priorities, proposals, budgets, and any other activities to be conducted by Orange County Community Action. The CAB consists of three sectors: public sector, private sector, and low-income community sector.

The Board appoints the eight members of the public sector, which is composed of up to three County Commissioners, up to three elected officials from three different municipalities located in Orange County, up to two members representing the state of Florida or United States Congress, and one member of the Orange County School Board.

There is currently one vacancy on the CAB for a municipal representative due to the term expiration of former Town of Eatonville Councilperson Tarus C. Mack. The Town of Eatonville has nominated Councilperson Marlin R. Daniels to fill the vacancy. The term is for four years.
