These expenditures are for the purpose(s) indicated below and will not be used to meet normal operating needs:

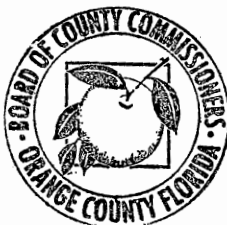
- 1) School Resource Officers, Crime Prevention, Safe Neighborhood or Drug Abuse Education and Prevention programs
