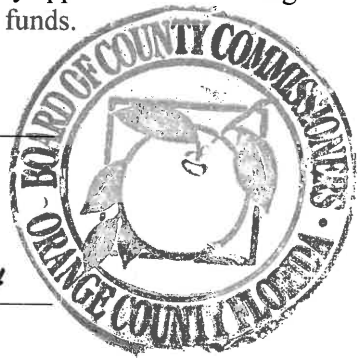
These expenditures are for the purpose(s) indicated below and will not be used to meet normal operating needs:
