On September 22, 2022, the Board approved an estimated budget for the Oaks Specialized Community Supervision Program in the amount of \$817,163. The Florida Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) has awarded year eight of the contract in the amount of \$680,632, which represents a decrease in the amount of \$136,531. The grant fiscal budget period is from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

With this funding, Orange County will continue to provide specialized community supervision to youth, between the ages of 10 - 17, that have shown to be moderate to high risk of continued involvement with the DJJ in Circuit 9.

On September 22, 2022, the Board approved an estimated budget for the HIV Emergency Relief Project Grant in the amount of \$10,578,529. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services awarded to the Health Services Department the grant in the amount of \$11,429,611. In addition, the grant project expects to receive an estimated program income amount of \$25,000. This brings the total current grant budget to \$11,454,611, which represents an increase of \$876,082. The budget period for this award is March 1, 2023 through February 28, 2024.

The Ryan White Part A Program provides health and support services for people with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) living in Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Lake counties. Funding is utilized for core and support services consisting of medical and dental care, nutritional supplements, insurance co-pay and premium payments, medical case management, pharmaceutical drug reimbursement, mental health counseling, and substance abuse treatment. Food, transportation, and psychosocial support services complement the program as support components.
