Orange County Sheriff's Office Community Crime Prevention Grant Program

Please submit a trust fund request for \$100,000 to fund the Orange County Sheriff's Office Community Crime Prevention Grant program.

The Community Crime Prevention Grant program will provide micro-grants ranging from \$2,500 - \$10,000 to nonprofit organizations, neighborhood groups and others engaged in projects or programs that address:

- Neighborhood safety
- Crime prevention
- Drug abuse education and prevention

The grants will enable community partners to work in alignment with the Orange County Sheriff's Office to support evidence-based violence reduction, safety and drug abuse education and prevention programs.

OCSO's Community Crime Prevention Grant program seeks to award a total of \$100,000 in grants that do not require applicants to provide matching funds. Applicants may request up to \$10,000 in funding, but the grant recipients and amounts will be selected at the sole discretion of the Orange County Sheriff's Office.
