ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y22-7018-CC, Parks Recreation Center Envelope Protection, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, CIC Construction Group USA, LLC, in the total contract award amount of \$1,156,607.

PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract includes design and construction to retrofit three designated evacuation shelters with exterior envelope protection to include windows, doors, and louvers. The project is located in Districts 1, 4, 5, and 6.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 8340-043-7325.

APPROVALS:

The Capital Projects Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Two bids were received in response to the Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The low bid is considered reasonable based on estimate and current market factors. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and CIC Construction Group USA, LLC has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to CIC Construction Group USA, LLC.
