The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$25,000 from the FY 2024 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purpose:

Contribution:

Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Florida – \$25,000. This contribution will be used to inspire and enable all young people, especially those from disadvantaged circumstances, to realize their full potential as productive, caring, and responsible citizens. By reaching children at an early age and providing positive activities and encouragement, Boys and Girls Clubs provide a compelling alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs, and other negative influences that affect our youth today.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$25,000 from the FY 2024 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for an eligible contribution to Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Florida.
