SUBJECT: Consultant Selection, Request for Proposals, Y23-813-SH, University

Boulevard Pedestrian/Cyclist Safety Study

RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. to provide University Boulevard Pedestrian/Cyclist Safety Study, Request for Proposals, Y23-813-SH. Request Board authorization for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a contract with a not-to-exceed budget of \$630,000.

The proposal was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on May 3, 2023. Commissioner Maribel Gomez Cordero was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

This contract will provide a technical evaluation of University Boulevard from Semoran Boulevard to Goldenrod Road to review the need for additional pedestrian, cyclist, and transit enhancements. This project is located in District 5.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1003-072-5156-3110.

DISCUSSION:

The focus of this project is to identify safety, access, and comfort needs of pedestrians and cyclists. The Consultant shall provide recommendations for enhancements of crosswalks at major intersecting streets and driveways, mid-block crossing countermeasures, and measures to guide pedestrians and cyclists towards crosswalks at the major intersections.

One proposal was received in response to this Request for Proposals (RFP). To ensure an open and competitive solicitation process, the RFP was posted on the County's e-procurement platform. A query from staff to potential proposers that declined to compete on this project resulted in the following:

- AVCON, Inc.: Did not respond to the inquiry.
- DRMP, Inc.: Did not respond to the inquiry.
- Kelly Collins & Gentry: Felt that the reference and Minority/Women Business Enterprise requirements were too restrictive.
- Luke Transportation Engineering Consultants: They reviewed the project scope and determined it would not fit for them to be the lead consultant but considered joining a team as a subconsultant.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposal in accordance with the criteria set forth in this RFP. The Procurement Committee's consensus scores are attached.
