Old Business:

Program Performance Summary Report Final Notification - 12/18/24

The program has received a deficiency as a result of leaving a child unattended in a classroom as discussed in a previous meeting. Head Start has 30 days to correct the deficiency from the date of the notice, however, since the winter break delayed the receipt of the notification, Ms. Hill will be requesting an extension to correct the deficiency. A corrective action plan has been developed and uploaded to the Head Start Enterprise System.

Community Representative Vote – Steve Martin, from Vystar Credit Union submitted an application. He listed his experience and personal history that qualifies him to serve as Community Representative. He also served on the 2023-2024 Policy Council and has been actively supporting Head Start for the last 8 years, providing financial literacy information. There was a unanimous vote to accept him in the role.
