ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y22-747-FH, Goldenrod Gym Chiller Replacement, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Air Mechanical & Service Corp. in the total contract award amount of \$359,000.

PROCUREMENT:

Work under this contract consists of the replacement of chillers, pumps, control and valve system that overcomes existing deficiencies. The project is located in District 5.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1023-043-2049-3810.

APPROVALS:

The Capital Projects and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Four bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bids from Comfort Aircon, Inc. and Integ Miami LLC were deemed non-responsive by the Procurement Division, based on the analysis provided by the Business Development Division, which identified that the M/WBE participation goal was not achieved, and sufficient good faith effort documentation was not provided. Air Mechanical & Service Corp. has a satisfactory record of performance for this type of work and has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Air Mechanical & Service Corp.

The Business Development Division evaluated four bids submitted for this project. The Business Development Division completed an M/WBE Availability Analysis. The scope of services for this project had limited Minority/Women Business Enterprise availability. As a result, the M/WBE goal was reduced to 9%. At the time of bid opening, at least 64 M/WBE firms were certified to provide the scope of services at the subcontract level.

The apparent low bidder, submitted by Air Mechanical & Service Corp., reported 18.38% in M/WBE participation. They met the 9% M/WBE participation goal. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:

The apparent second low bidder, submitted by Orange County MBE firm Comfort Aircon, Inc., is bidding as a Prime contractor. Therefore, Comfort Aircon, Inc., is required to self-perform no less than 51% of the contract per Sec. 17-321 per the M/WBE Ordinance. In the event this requirement is not achieved, other M/WBE's will have to be included to achieve the 9% M/WBE goal. Comfort Aircon, Inc., reported self-performing 95% with 0% subcontractor's participation on attachment C-2. They did not meet the 9% M/WBE participation goal and did not achieve good faith effort documentation.

The apparent third low bidder, submitted by Gibson Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, LLC, reported 18.94% in M/WBE participation. They met the 9% M/WBE participation goal. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:

The fourth low bidder, submitted by Integ Miami, LLC, reported 4.50% in M/WBE participation. While they listed M/WBE Diversified Supply in their bid; they did not specify their scopes of services nor scope of classification on attachment C-2. The fourth low bidder included the signed Letter of Intent denoting the scopes of services. Per Contact Article IV, Contract Documents, all information should be considered. They did not meet the 9% M/WBE participation goal and did not achieve good faith effort documentation. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:
