
The Business Development Division evaluated the three bids submitted for this project and found that at the time of bid opening, there were at least six firms certified at the sub level in the scope of service. The apparent low bidder Mercon Construction Company did not meet the Orange County M/WBE participation goal of 25%. While they reported \$675,065 in M/WBE participation, they did not specify the work to be performed on attachment C-2. Therefore, the M/WBE participation could not be confirmed. They did not provide good faith effort documentation.

The second low bid submitted by Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. did not meet the Orange County M/WBE participation goal of 25%. They reported 11% M/WBE participation in their bid and did not provide good faith effort documentation. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:

The third low bid submitted by Hubbard Construction Company did not meet the Orange County M/WBE participation goal of 25%. They reported 13% M/WBE participation in their bid and did not provide good faith effort documentation. Please note the following certified M/WBE participation:
