- Orange County Code Chapter 9, Article XII provides for the creation of a board to be known as the Board of Adjustment and Appeals of Underground Utilities Pipeline Contractors (Board).
- The Board was created in 1972.
- Board Composition:
 - 5 members appointed by the BCC
 - 3 members state certified contractors
 - 1 member professional engineer
 - 1 member certified underground utilities contractor



The Board responsibilities are:

- To qualify applicants for the county competency examination.
- To conduct examination and grant authority for the issuance of the Competency Cards.
- To hear appeals regarding underground utilities pipeline contracting work.
- Update the competency examination.



- The Board has been affected by the challenges of filling the very specific membership categories.
- The lack of quorum has rendered the Board ineffective in carrying out its duties.
- The Membership and Mission Review Board (MMRB) identified, discussed and recommended to sunset this board.



Recommendation

- Amend Chapter 9 ("Building and Construction Regulations") of the Orange County Code; Amend Article XII ("Underground Utilities Pipelines and Underground Utilities Pipeline Contractors")
- Sunset the Board
- Create a committee with five (5) county staff and two (2) staff from local municipalities to replace the Board.
- Appeals to be heard by the Public Works Advisory Board.
