SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 4, Contract Y20-2012, Provision of Community
Services and Facility Use

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 4, Contract Y20-2012, Provision of Community Services and Facility Use, with City Year, Inc., in the amount of \$100,000, for a revised contract total amount of \$300,000.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment extends the contract for the period of July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 and adds additional funding to cover this extension. Aligning the contract term with the calendar year allows the contract to provide continuity of services accompanied by calendar year funding.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-062-2556-8610.

APPROVALS:

The Citizens' Commission for Children Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

The Board approved Contract Y20-2012 on February 25, 2020. City Year, Inc. is currently providing satisfactory services under this contract. Under this contract, City Year, Inc. provides Youth Mentoring services to youth up to 17 years of age and/or completing the 12th grade year residing in Sectors 1, 2 and 3.

Previous amendments to the contract are as follows:

Amendment No. 1: Updated Attachment A-1 and A-2.

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Amendment No. 2: Renewed the contract for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. The contract amount remained unchanged. Updated Attachments A-1 and A-2, Article XI, Article XIII, Article XIV, Article XV and Exhibits B and C.

Amendment No. 3: Renewed the contract for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.
