## MODIFICATION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

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## Resolution No. 2020-M-51

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WHEREAS, on April 9, 1990, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida (the "Board") established the Community Redevelopment Agency of Orange County, Florida (the "Agency") pursuant to the provisions of Part III, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (the "Community Redevelopment Act") and Resolution No. 90-M-23, finding the existence of one or more slum or blighted areas in the City of Orlando and the County in an area of the County known as South Orange Blossom Trail (the "Community Redevelopment Area"); and

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WHEREAS, on June 11, 1990, the Board adopted a Redevelopment Plan pursuant to the Community Redevelopment Act and Resolution No. 90-M-33 (the "Plan") with an initial term of thirty (30) years; and

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WHEREAS, on June 11, 1990 the Board also enacted Ordinance No. 90-13 establishing a Community Redevelopment Trust Fund in order to implement community redevelopment in the Community Redevelopment Area; and

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WHEREAS, on March 26, 1991, the Agency entered into an agreement with the Orange Blossom Trail Development Board, Inc., a Florida non-profit corporation (the "Development Board") on March 26, 1991 pursuant to which the Agency contracted with the Development Board to implement redevelopment programs in the Community Redevelopment Area; and

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WHEREAS, on May 8, 2007, the Agency entered into a new agreement with the Development Board relating to redevelopment activities in the Community Redevelopment Area (the "Agreement") which Agreement, as amended, shall expire on January 1, 2021; and

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WHEREAS, in 2017, the Development Board commissioned a study by GAI Consultants, Inc. entitled "OBT Next" to evaluate the existing conditions within the Community Development Area (the "Area"); and

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WHEREAS, the OBT Next report indicated that little redevelopment or investment in the Area had occurred since the Plan was adopted and proposed to (i) update the Plan, (ii) extend the Plan for a period of thirty (30) years beyond the expiration of its initial term, and (iii) expand redevelopment beyond the existing boundaries of the Area; and

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WHEREAS, the Board concurs with certain findings in the OBT Next report, and hereby finds that slum and blighted areas continue to exist within the boundaries of the Area and re-adopts the Board's findings in Resolution No. 90-M-23 and Resolution No. 90-M-33; and

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50	WHEREAS, the Board also finds that the continued existence of the Agency and
52	rehabilitation or redevelopment of the Area is necessary in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare and that such interests will best be served by an extension of its existence and the Plan for a period of approximately twenty nine (29) years; that further study and analysis of
54	the best methods for implementation of the Plan is necessary; and that its decision to extend the Plan shall not be construed as an adoption of the entire OBT Next report itself or an expansion of
56	the boundaries of the Area.
58	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:
60	<b>Section 1.</b> The foregoing recitals are true and correct and adopted as a part of this Resolution.
64	<b>Section 2.</b> The Board hereby adopts and approves the continued existence of the Agency and modification of the Plan to extend the duration of the Plan until September 30, 2049
66	at which time the Agency and the Plan shall terminate and cease to exist.
68	<b>Section 3.</b> Upon adoption of this Resolution by the Board, such Plan, as extended, shall be deemed to be in full force and effect.
