Amendment to Transportation Impact Fee Ordinance Relating to

Exemptions

The Transportation Impact Fee Ordinance, codified at Article IV of Chapter 23, Orange County Code, provides for certain exemptions from assessment of impact fees at Section 23-98 ("Exemptions"). This change will allow County staff to effectively and efficiently process, review, and evaluate proposed housing developments in order to maximize the provisions of affordable housing options in our community.

Make a Finding of Consistency with the Comprehensive Plan and Approval of Ordinance amending Article IV of Chapter 23 (the "Transportation Impact Fee Ordinance") by amending

27	"affordable" pursuant to Section 163.31801(119), Florida Statutes, as may be amended			
28	or superseded, may be exempted from all or a portion of the payment of impact fees.
