## RECOMMENDATION

Selection of CDM Smith Inc. to provide Continuing Professional Consulting Services for Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) Services, Request for Proposals Y18-906-CH. Further recommend the Board authorize execution of the final contract by the Procurement Division to establish hourly rates for future requirements. The contract performance period will be for one year with two 1year renewals.

This item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on July 11, 2018. Commissioner Victoria P. Siplin was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

## <u>PURPOSE</u>

To provide continuing consulting services for construction engineering and inspection (CEI) services as needed.

## DISCUSSION

The consultant will provide project management and support services to oversee the construction of a variety of County transportation and roadway construction projects. Services will include engineering and inspection services, coordination with contractors, shop drawing reviews, evaluation and negotiation of change orders, and review of pay requests.

To ensure an open and competitive process, the Request for Proposals was posted on the Orange County website. One proposal was received in response to the solicitation. Queries from staff to those proposers who declined to compete on this solicitation resulted in the following findings:

- 1. Great Engineering Services, Inc. stated they did not pursue this solicitation because they did not have the required similar project experience.
- 2. Page One Consultants, Inc. has joined the team as a subconsultant.
- 3. PES, LLC has joined the team as a subconsultant.
- 4. GRL Engineers has joined the team as a subconsultant.

The single proposal is likely due to the high demand for services in our area because of the current volume of roadway construction, including I-4 Ultimate and numerous other large state projects. Many of the engineering construction firms in our area are already involved in those construction projects and may not be able to take on additional workload. The County's previous CEI contract averaged less than \$430,000 of work per year over three years. The value of this contract is considered relatively small when compared to the industry demand. CDM Smith Inc. has a satisfactory performance record with the County and other governmental entities. In addition, their costs are consistent with industry standards, and they have been responsive to the County's needs.

The Procurement Committee has evaluated the single proposal received by CDM Smith Inc. and are comfortable that the proposer can fulfill the requirements of the contract and the needs of the Highway Construction Division as well as the various departments and divisions throughout the County.

The consensus scores of the Procurement Committee are attached.
