Installation of "Stop" signs on Tiny Road at the Bridgewater Middle

School parent loop entrance

Based upon a citizen's request, the Traffic Engineering Division performed a field evaluation regarding a sight distance concern for vehicles approaching the intersection of Tiny Road and Bridgewater Crossings Boulevard. The current traffic control for this intersection of Tiny Road and Bridgewater Crossings Boulevard is a "Stop" sign for westbound traffic. After a field evaluation, the Traffic Engineering Division has determined that there is no sight distance issue at this intersection.

The field evaluation did uncover an issue at the southern entrance to the school at the parent loop entrance on Tiny Road. There are multiple concerns at this location, which is also where a majority of the students are crossing with the assistance of a crossing guard. Traffic Engineering is proposing to make this intersection an "ALL WAY STOP" with the addition of "Stop" signs on both northbound and southbound Tiny Road at the Bridgewater Middle School parent loop entrance. This will increase vehicle and pedestrian visibility and safety at this intersection.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of "Stop" signs on the north and south approaches on Tiny Road at the Bridgewater Middle School parent loop entrance.

Action Requested: Approval of "Stop" signs installation on the north and south approaches on Tiny Road at the Bridgewater Middle School parent loop entrance. District 1.


